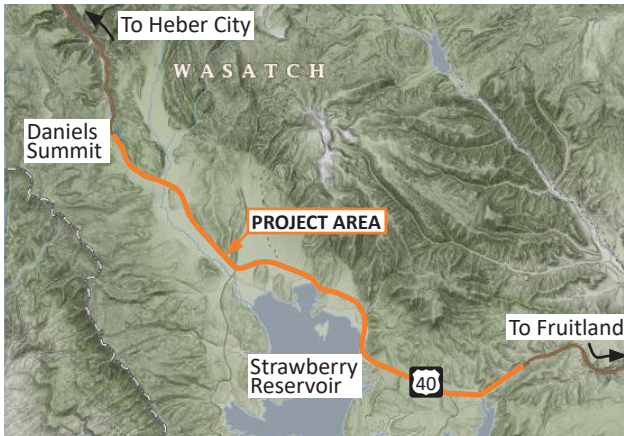


CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

U.S. 40 Daniels Summit to Soldier Creek Resurfacing

On July 25, 2017, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is scheduled to begin construction on U.S. Highway 40 from Daniels Summit to Soldier Creek (milepost 34 to 52). This project will resurface the roadway with a chip seal coat to extend the life of the pavement and provide a smoother driving surface. The work is scheduled to take approximately four weeks.



CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Work is scheduled during daylight hours, Monday through Friday, with work ending on Fridays at 3 p.m.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane intermittently with a flagger or pilot car to guide traffic through the work zone.
- Freight carriers and motorists can expect up to 15-minute delays.
- Brief access interruptions to businesses, residences, and recreational areas may occur.
- Motorists are advised to reduce speeds in the work zone.
- Cyclists are advised to use alternative routes during the resurfacing period, if possible.
