Prevention Steps:

- Before driving, check the street, driveway, and area around your vehicle
- Drivers of SUVs and trucks should be extra careful
- Children should be taught not to play in, under, or around vehicles
- Supervise children when a driver is leaving the home
- Adjust the driver's seat as high as needed to see clearly out the rear window
- Roll down windows to hear children
- Adjust side and rear mirrors to reduce blind spots

Major Risk Factors:

- Children under 5 years of age
- High profile vehicles such as SUVs, vans, and trucks
- Vehicles travelling in reverse
- Rushed and distracted driving

ST. LAWRENCE CATHOLIC CHURCH BUILDING 100th ANNIVERSARY



One of Heber City's most beautiful and iconic landmarks is celebrating its 100th birthday! St. Lawrence Catholic Church, located at the corner of Center Street and 100 West, was dedicated on December 26, 1915, and served as the LDS Church Second Ward meeting house until it was sold to the Catholic Church in the 1960's. The building was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1978.



On June 13, 2015, St. Lawrence Catholic Church will be celebrating by holding an open house from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The public is invited to come and see one of our local treasures.

HEBER CITY MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION

NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL OFFICES to be voted on in the Heber City Municipal General Election to be held November 3, 2015: 3 City Council Members - 4 year term each.

Candidate filing period is June 1, 2015 through June 8, 2015. Declaration of Candidacy forms or Nomination Petitions must be filed in person with the City Recorder at 75 North Main, Heber City, Utah, during the normal business hours of 7:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

In accordance with Heber City Code, individuals filing as candidates for the Heber City Council shall pay a \$50.00 fee at the time of filing their candidacy with the City Recorder. This filing fee shall be refundable only if it is determined that the person filing is not qualified to be a candidate, or who is found to have improperly filed. (Ord. 2003-25, 2003)

The fee for a 12' x 24' plot is \$50, for a 12' x 11' plot, the fee is \$35, and for a 12' x 6' plot, the fee is \$20. Additionally, a \$25 community garden usage fee will apply to non-Heber City residents.
