## INCREASE IN SEWER AND UTILITY FEE RATES

The recently adopted 2015-2016 Operating Budget includes a 10% rate increase in Sewer rates and a 15% increase in Utility/Storm Drain fees. These increases will go into effect on the August 1<sup>st</sup> utility billing. For Sewer rates, the base rate will increase from \$12.45 to \$13.70 per month and the flowage charge will increase from .89¢ to .98¢ per thousand gallons. The Utility Fee for single family dwellings will increase from \$4.83 to \$5.55 per month and similar increases will be seen for multi-family and non-residential properties. These increases are necessary to deal with increased operational costs and an aging infrastructure.


## HEBER VALLEY FARMERS MARKET AND CONCERTS IN THE PARK
