


## HOT OVEN, HOT CAR – IT'S THE SAME THING




## NORTHWEST SEWER LINE PROJECT

The Heber City 2015 Northwest Sewer Improvements project is underway. The project includes installing a new sewer line in the following locations: 300 North from 600 West to 400 West; 400 West from 300 North to 400 North; 400 North from 400 West to 300 West; 300 West from 400 North to 500 North; 500 North from 300 West to 100 West; and 100 West from 500 North to 750 North. The contractor, Geneva Rock Products, Inc. will endeavor to minimize disruptions and maintain access to residents' homes during construction. Anticipated project completion is June 2016.
