## SNOW REMOVAL AND PARKING

It's November and the snow is coming; with that, comes sidewalk snow removal and snow removal parking.

The Heber City Police Department Code Enforcement would like to remind you that it is your responsibility to shovel any sidewalks that are connected to your property. Failure to do so puts you at risk of a lawsuit for any damage or injury resulting from the built up snow and ice on the sidewalks or causing pedestrians to walk in the roadway.

Starting November 1<sup>st</sup>, Heber City Municipal Code 10.16.040, Parking During Snow Clean Up Periods goes into effect. Heber City Police Department, working in conjunction with Heber City Public Works will be actively ticketing any violators of this code.

### 10.16.040 Parking During Snow Cleanup Periods

#### A. **No parking during snow removal hours.**

Beginning November 15<sup>th</sup> of each year and terminating April 1<sup>st</sup>, it is unlawful to park or leave parked any vehicle upon the City's paved portion of the street or within five feet thereof under the following circumstances:

1. When there is any amount of snow on the street;
2. When it is actually snowing or within twenty-four hours thereafter; or
3. The street has not been plowed since the snow fell.

B. **Impounding vehicles.** Any vehicle parked in violation of Subsection A of this Section may be impounded and no person shall recover any vehicle thus removed without first paying the cost of removal and the cost of storage.

## CEMETERY CLEAN UP NOTICE

Heber City Cemetery will be conducting a clean-up beginning **on Monday, November 7, 2016**. The clean-up will last approximately four days. We ask that any decorations that visitors wish to save be removed before the scheduled clean-up.
