UTILITY SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE GENERAL FUND

Annually the City provides the cost of Utility services provided to the General Fund. This is for informational purposes to be provided to the citizens. Per Section 10.6.135.5 of the Utah State Code: Notice is hereby given that the Heber City Council will hold a public hearing on Thursday, June 18, 2020 at 6:00 pm to discuss unbilled services provided by the Water, Sewer and Utility Enterprise Funds to the Heber City General Fund. The estimated value of the services the General Fund receives is as follows: Water \$43,200, Pressurized Irrigation \$8,400, Sewer \$3,200 and Utility \$2,700. Interested citizens are invited to attend the hearing and express support or opposition to the proposed practice.

FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 BUDGET ADOPTION

The City annually prepares a balanced budget for the provision of city services to its residents. This budget is developed over a number of months and is one of the most important policy documents adopted each year. It sets the legal budgetary limits in which the city departments are allowed to operate. The current fiscal year budget is prepared with no property tax increases in mind based in part on recent events. The City seeks citizen feedback during the public hearing regarding the tentative budget on June 2nd, 2020 at 6:00 pm.

City Staff invite all interested parties to participate in the June 16th City Council Meeting. Council will consider the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget. The Public Hearing will be held on June 2nd, 2020 at the Heber City Municipal Building located at 75 North Main Street in Heber City. Starting June 17 through 8:00 pm on Election Day, you may return your voted ballot in the new outside

drive-thru ballot drop box located at the County Building at 25 N. Main Street, Heber. The box is located on the north west side of the building.

TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM WASTE WATER CAPITAL FUND 67 TO WASTE WATER IMPACT FUND 57

Heber City's tentative budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 includes an interfund loan from the Wastewater Capital Fund (Fund #67) to the Waste Water Impact Fund (Fund #57) to cover the costs of two sewer main extension projects extending sewer line north of town (Projects S-034 and S-005). In accordance with state code section 10-6-132 the City must notify residents seven days in advance of the public hearing established to receive public input on the proposed interfund loan. The date and time of the public hearing to receive public input on the proposed interfund loan is Tuesday, June 16th, at 6 pm. The location of the public hearing is Heber City Hall located at 75 North Main Street, Heber City, Utah. The City Council intends to consider the establishment of a ten (10) year promissory note issued by Fund 57 to fund 67 in the amount of \$1,030,000. The annual principal repayment is \$103,000. Interest will be calculated at the prevailing interest rate offered by the State Treasurer PTIF earned in the prior year and paid on July 1st of each year.
