## Utah Strong Recovery Project

The Utah Strong Recovery Project started in July 2020. It is a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funded program to help Utahns impacted by the stressors of the Covid19 pandemic. It provides **free and confidential counseling** by FEMA trained counselors to anyone in Utah in the form of emotional support, coping and problem- solving strategies, mental health education, and community referrals. Spanish speaking counselors are available and translation for other languages is offered.

The state has 40 counselors on standby to answer helpline calls from people who are experiencing stress, anxiety or depression because of the COVID-19 pandemic. There is a Wasatch County Team available for individual in-person and online counseling. The Team is also available to present to community organizations. You can call and request the Wasatch County Team through the Utah Strong Recovery Project Helpline.

## General Election

### November 3<sup>rd</sup>

The 2020 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The General Election will be conducted primarily by mail with paper ballots only. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters on **October 13<sup>th</sup>**.

Completed ballots will need to be mailed and postmarked no later than the day **before** Election Day November 2, 2020. Ballots may also be dropped off in person during Early Voting, on Election Day, or at the Wasatch County Clerk's office until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. ### Ballot Drop Box Locations

You may drop off your ballot inside the Wasatch County Clerk's Office located at 25 N. Main Street during the regular business hours of 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

An Outside Ballot Drop Box is available 24 hours a day, October 13 – November 3, 2020 until 8:00 pm located at 25 N. Main Street on the North West side of the Building.

### In Person Voting Locations and Hours

Drive through in-person paper ballot voting and same day registration by provisional ballot will be available on Election Day November 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Wasatch County Outdoor Arena Located at 415 S Southfields RD (1200 West) in Heber City, between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

**Early Voting** will be offered during regular business hours of 8:00 am – 5:00 pm on October 27<sup>th</sup>- 30<sup>th</sup> at the County Clerk's Office located at 25 N. Main Street.

## Maintaining Trees in Park Strips

The Public Works Department would like to remind everyone who has trees or bushes planted in their park strips between the sidewalk and the road that the area must be maintained. We are finding there are several trees around the City that are either blocking the views of street intersections, hanging too low over City sidewalks or causing obstructions for pedestrians. At times, these items are blocking the right of way along the shoulder of the road such that our street sweeper is unable to reach the edge of the curb to clear the gutters. Please note that per Heber City Code 12.20.110 – Pruning & Corner Clearance, homeowners are responsible for keeping these trees neatly trimmed and in compliance with the specifications noted in this code. Thank you for your cooperation in helping to keep our streets and sidewalks safe and clear of overgrown trees & bushes!
