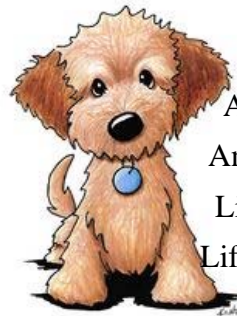


## CEMETERY CLEAN UP NOTICE

## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COYOTE LANE**

Coyote Lane will be temporarily closed to public access from March through June 2021, due to improvements and reconstruction of the new Coyote Lane. Message boards will be installed prior to the official closure. The suggested alternative route for Coyote Lane is 5<sup>th</sup> North off Main Street, 550 East, and Valley Hills Blvd. Please plan alternate routes for a period of 90 to 120 days after the closure. The Coyote Lane trailhead will also be closed for a portion of the Spring/Summer. During this time pedestrians and cyclists are asked to utilize the Utah Valley University (UVU) trail head. ## **HEBER CITY AIRPORT MASTERPLAN UPDATE**

Work on Heber City's Airport Masterplan Update will commence again on April 1<sup>st</sup> with a virtual public meeting after nearly a year hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The project's web site is the primary source for accurate and timely information. The web site can also be used

## **CLEARING SNOW FROM FIRE HYDRANTS**

In an emergency, every second counts. Fire hydrants that are blocked, concealed, or difficult to access due to snow or ice can impede emergency fire response. Fire trucks carry a limited amount of water, so one of the first tasks upon arriving at a fire is to locate a water supply from the nearest hydrant. Hydrants covered in snow can be difficult to locate, and uncovering them can waste valuable time needed during the fire fight. Keeping them clear can mean easier access to water and more time doing what really matters - fighting the fire.

### *How to Keep Fire Hydrants Clear*

It is necessary to keep a three-foot radius around a fire hydrant clear, as well as maintain a shoveled path from the street, sidewalk or driveway to the fire hydrant so that it is visible from the road and firefighters can easily access it.



### *Who Should Clear Hydrants*

It is generally considered the responsibility of the residents occupying property near a hydrant. Consider helping elderly friends, neighbors, or those with medical conditions to keep their fire hydrants clear.
