MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Domestic Violence Awareness Month

Despite the increasing awareness and public discussion around the terrible reality of domestic violence we are still seeing unacceptable statistics in our state. Representatives from the Peace House joined our meeting and the Heber City Council voted on a proclamation that recognizes the problem and declares October Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

From the proclamation:

“In Utah 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men are physically abused by an intimate partner and 42% of adult homicides are domestic violence related.

Research shows that by creating communities where people are connected, supportive and care for one another, there are fewer incidents of domestic violence

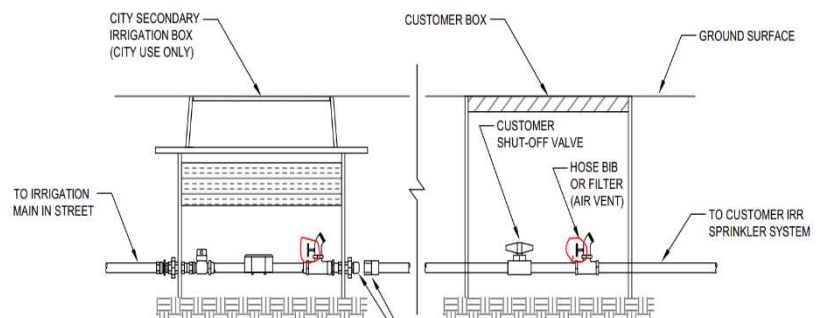


DITCH & PRESSURIZED IRRIGATION SEASON HAS ENDED

Flood/ditch irrigation season ended on Sunday, September 26th, 2021.

Pressurized irrigation season ended on Tuesday, September 28th, 2021.

Heber City Public Works would like to remind all residents with access to pressurized irrigation to please remember to **turn the valve in their irrigation boxes to the open position** for the hose spigot or filter compartment in order to allow any residual water to drain. This prevents freezing of the irrigation lines and equipment during the cold winter months. Thank you for your cooperation.

Municipal Election

November 2nd

The 2021 Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021. The Election will be conducted by mail with paper ballots only. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters on **October 12th**. The last day to register on-line as a voter is October 22, 2021. You can register at vote.utah.gov.



Completed ballots need to be mailed and postmarked no later than the day **before** Election Day November 1, 2021. Ballots may also be dropped off in person at the Wasatch County Clerk's office until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Ballot Drop Box Locations



You may drop off your ballot inside the Wasatch County Clerk's Office located at 25 N. Main Street during the regular business hours of 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

An Outside Ballot Drop Box is available 24 hours a day, October 12 – November 2, 2021 until 8:00 pm located at 25 N. Main Street on the North West side of the Building.

Drive through in-person paper ballot voting and same day registration by provisional ballot will be available on Election Day November 2nd at the Wasatch County Outdoor Arena Located at 415 S Southfields RD (1200 West) in Heber City, between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
