


HEBER CITY TREE LIGHTING CEREMONY – SAVE THE DATE!

BACKFLOW PREVENTION

A backflow prevention assembly is used to protect potable water supplies from contamination or pollution due to backflow. In our water supply system, water is normally maintained at a significant pressure to enable water to flow from the tap, shower, or other fixture. However, water pressure may fail or be reduced when a water main bursts, pipes freeze, or there is an unexpected high demand on the water system (for example, when several fire hydrants are opened at once). Reduced pressure in the main waterline could allow contaminated water from the soil, from storage, or from other sources within your business or residence to be drawn up into the system, contaminating the drinking water. This is called backflow. To ensure that water users protect our water system against contamination, we require that all connections to a potential source of contamination be protected with an approved backflow prevention assembly.



Backflow prevention assemblies must be tested by a certified tester upon install, after a significant repair, or at least once a year. Once a test has been performed, please send a copy of the results to backflow@heberut.gov.

PREPARING FOR SNOWPLOWING SEASON: TREE TRIMMING

With the winter season rapidly approaching, Public Works is preparing for snowplowing operations to begin. We ask residents to please trim any tree limbs extending beyond the curb and gutter as soon as possible in order to ensure snowplows can adequately remove snow and to avoid damages to the City's snow removal equipment.

Also, please note that when trimming trees and shrubs in the park strips, homeowners/property owners must remove all pruned limbs, branches & leaves & properly dispose of them. Tree trimmings may not be left in the public right-of-way, nor may they be allowed to fall down nearby storm drains, as such trimmings clog storm drains and impede our storm water system. (See *Heber City Municipal Code 12.20.100: Public Tree Care.*) Thank you for helping to maintain the trees in the park strips! We appreciate your cooperation with this effort.

Any tree limbs extending beyond the curb and gutter which residents fail to remove will be trimmed by Public Works. Thank you for your cooperation.



SNOW REMOVAL AND STREET PARKING

It's November and the snow is coming; with that, comes sidewalk and street snow removal.

The Heber City Police Department Code Enforcement would like to remind you that it is your responsibility to shovel any sidewalks that are connected to your property. Failure to do so puts you at risk of a lawsuit for any damage or injury resulting from the build-up of snow and ice on the sidewalks or causing pedestrians to walk in the roadway.

This also serves as a reminder to keep a three-foot radius around your fire hydrant clear from excess snow build up.

Heber City Municipal Code 10.16.040, Parking During Snow Clean Up Periods is in effect. As per code, it is unlawful to park or leave parked any vehicle upon the City's paved portion of the street or within five feet thereof under the following circumstances:

1. When there is any amount of snow on the street;
2. When it is actually snowing or within twenty-four hours thereafter; or
3. The street has not been plowed since the snow fell.

IRRIGATION DITCH MAINTENANCE

The City would like to encourage homeowners with irrigation ditches running in front of their homes, to check and clean any debris and weeds that may have accumulated there during the fall.



Now that the irrigation season is over, a little preventative maintenance will ensure that winter drainage can flow safely past their properties.
