You can have your utility payment automatically withdrawn from your bank account each month. Payment will be withdrawn from your account on the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month. Participation is voluntary and this service can be terminated upon your request. You can go to the City Office to complete the authorization agreement. You will need to bring a VOIDED check with the bank routing number (9-digits) and your bank account number.
